President and CEO, Matt Wyatt, states that the purpose in creating Tutela Medicus was two-fold.

Wyatt explains that “the first purpose was to provide a vehicle for a physician inventor the opportunity to present intellectual property. The Tutela Medicus value proposition is to then facilitate the process to intellectual property, but also increase the probability of identifying an industry sponsor while increasing the royalty return for the physician and minimizing time to market.”

Additionally, “industry has always struggled with managing physician ideas. Companies have many mission critical objectives and simply cannot manage the volume of concepts or decipher if the ideas are consistent with its company needs,” Wyatt continued.

The development services provided by Tutela Medicus will range from early concept development through analysis and product testing. Patent search services and close ties to manufacturing will ensure that the concept is feasible in terms of market deployment. Onsite rapid prototyping and finite-element computer analysis will assist in making the transition from early concept to physical product as timely as possible.

The company will begin operations from a leased facility on East 86th street in Indianapolis but is currently looking at alternative sites with the assistance of Ginovus, an economic development and site selection services firm.
